MODEL(S): All versions of the 29LTD

DESCRIPTION: Meter needle sticks after transmit, and there is no receive. Pushing the

Soundtracker button (if equipped) may restore proper operation.

ACTION: At this time the specific cause is unknown, but appears to be influenced by the

antenna configuration. Attempting to duplicate the symptom is extremely

difficult. Recommendations:

➤ Check and adjust the SWR. Even if the SWR looks good, try adjusting it.

> Try relocating the antenna (if possible).

➤ On a mirror-mount antenna, connect a #14 (or larger) ground wire from a bolt on the antenna bracket to a bolt on the door hinge.

> Connect a ground wire to a screw on the side of the radio.

As a last resort try a different antenna.

ADJUSTMENTS: Check and adjust the SWR.

NOTES: None.
